
कॉलेज ऑफ फार्मसी, नाशिक ही 1982 मध्ये स्थापन झालेली शासकीय अनुदानित संस्था (बी.फार्मसी आभ्यासक्रम) आहे. बी.फार्मसी कोर्स 1982 मध्ये सुरु झाला, एम.फार्मसी कोर्स 1986 मध्ये, पीएचडी.. 2003 मध्ये कोर्स आणि 2021 मध्ये डी.फार्म कोर्स. कॉलेज नॅशनल स्किल्स क्वालिफिकेशन फ्रेमवर्क (एन.एस.क्यू.एफ.)अंतर्गत व्यावसायिक अभ्यासक्रम ड्रग रेग्युलेटरी अफेअर्स आणि बौद्धिक संपदा अधिकार मध्ये डिप्लोमा देखील चालवते. कॉलेजला ऑल इंडिया कौन्सिल फॉर टेक्निकल एज्युकेशन, फार्मसी कौन्सिल ऑफ इंडिया, नवी दिल्ली, यांनी मान्यता दिली आहे, तसेच विद्यापीठ अनुदान आयोग द्वारे कलम 2 (f) आणि 12 (b) द्वारे मान्यताप्राप्त आहे. कॉलेज कायमस्वरूपी सावित्रीबाई फुले पुणे विद्यापीठ, पुणे यांच्याशी संलग्न आहे. सावित्रीबाई फुले पुणे विद्यापीठ, भारतातील प्रमुख विद्यापीठांपैकी एक, पुणे शहराच्या उत्तर-पश्चिम भागात स्थित आहे. हे सुमारे 411 एकर क्षेत्र व्यापलेले आहे. पूना विद्यापीठ कायद्यांतर्गत 10 फेब्रुवारी 1949 रोजी त्याची स्थापना झाली. विद्यापीठात 46 शैक्षणिक विभाग आहेत. हे 'ऑक्सफर्ड ऑफ द ईस्ट' म्हणून प्रसिद्ध आहे. यामध्ये सुमारे 307 मान्यताप्राप्त संशोधन संस्था आणि 612 संलग्न महाविद्यालये पदवी आणि पदवीपूर्व अभ्यासक्रम ऑफर करतात.




